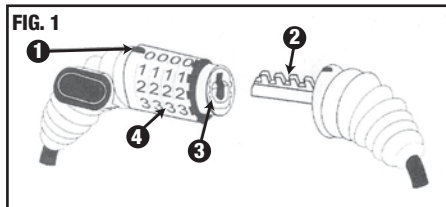
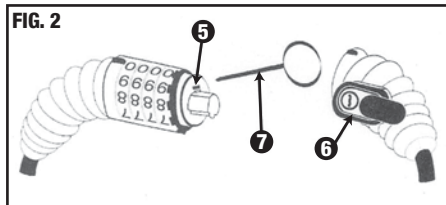
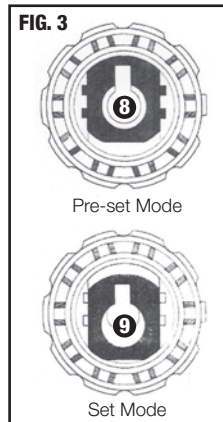


Lasso KONG Cable Lock Instructions



- 1 Guide Point
- 2 Lock Post
- 3 Reset Dial
- 4 Number Dials
- 5 Combo Slot
- 6 Key Slot



- 7 Searching Key
- 8 Setting Button (In pre-set position)
- 9 Setting Button (In set position)

First Time Use – Initial Setting of Your Combination:

1. Line up the guide point with the default combination: 0-0-0-0. (Figure 1)
2. Pull the lock apart. If you have aligned the combination correctly, the cable should separate easily.
3. Push down the center of the Reset Dial until you feel it click into place. (Figure 3)
4. Choose your desired combination by lining your selection up with the guide point.
5. Taking care not to move the number dials, return the Reset Dial to its original position by flipping the setting button back up until you feel it click again.
6. **IMPORTANT!** To verify your new combination before using your lock, insert the lock post all the way into the barrel but do not turn the dials. Remove the lock post and your Lasso is now ready for use.

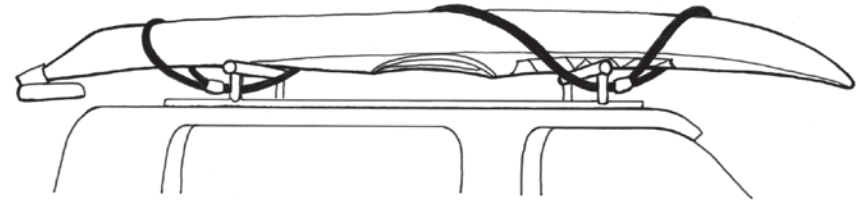
Using the Combo Searching Key:

This feature allows you to reset an improperly set or forgotten combination. To use this function, your lock must be unlocked from the Key Slot. (Figure 2)

1. Insert Searching Key into the slot provided until it stops. (Figure 2)
2. Turn the first Number Dial until you feel the searching key slide in further. When the correct number has been found and the pin is fully inserted, that number will no longer turn. This is how you know it is right.
3. Continue with procedure 2 & 3 on the second, third and fourth dials until the Searching Key is fully inserted and the combo mechanism releases from the opposite side of the lock.
4. Write down your combo for future reference, or if you wish to choose a new combination, return to “First Time Use” steps 2 – 4.

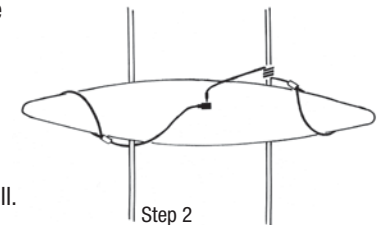
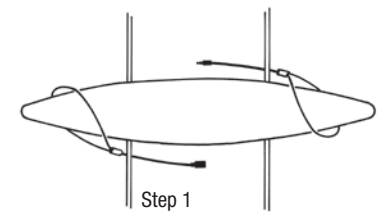

Cable locks for your kayak



Installation is simple ...

1. Secure boat on any standard rooftop rack according to manufacturer's directions. Be sure that your roof racks are locked to the vehicle. Loop Lasso ends around bow and stern of boat, with cable running under the rack.
 2. Wrap Lasso around rack to tighten. Pull the large loop as far down the boat as possible before taking up the slack around the bars of your roof rack. Then secure the cable lock.
- ◆ Lasso Security Cables work with many touring kayaks to help keep the hatch covers secure as well.
 - ◆ You can use your Lasso to secure your kayak to any stationary object.
